



Registration ID activation involves a few simple steps:

Open the Embase Registration ID page at: <http://www.embase.com/register>

1) In the below box that opens, **TYPE** in the **Registration ID** and **Registration password** in the appropriate boxes and press “Continue”.




3) The next step depends on whether you (already) have an Elsevier account.

- a) If you already have an Elsevier account, you can sign in via Username and password OR via your institution.






