

Registration ID activation involves a few simple steps:

Open the Embase Registration ID page at: <u>http://www.embase.com/register</u>

1) In the below box that opens, **TYPE in** the **Registration ID** and **Registration password** in the appropriate boxes and press "**Continue**".



2) You will see a redemption success screen and press continue.



3) The next step depends on whether you (<u>already</u>) have an Elsevier account.
